Thank you for your interest in the Adobe Certified Associate (ACA) Approved Courseware Publisher Program. Your participation is vital to creating a healthy community of individuals seeking the ACA credential. Adobe and Certiport have teamed up with ProCert Labs, an independent courseware and curriculum review company, to provide our publisher partners a value-added path to certifying their ACA courseware.

The Approved Courseware distinction provides publishers with a number of benefits:

- Recognition from Adobe, including a license to use Adobe's ACA logo indicating the approved status
- Inclusion in marketing efforts to the Education market by Adobe and Certiport
- A complimentary ProCert Labs instructional design review of your course that includes course strengths, weaknesses, and quotable commentary for use in marketing efforts

What to expect

To achieve the Approved Courseware distinction, course materials must be reviewed and certified by ProCert Labs. ProCert Labs conducts independent, comprehensive assessments against the stated ACA exam objectives, ensuring that all approved courseware demonstrates 100% alignment to the ACA exam objectives required by Adobe. There is a review fee per course submitted.

The ProCert Labs review process is approximately three to four weeks. Course materials submitted in languages other than English may take additional time for review.

If your course passes the initial ProCert Labs review:

- You will be authorized to use the ACA Approved Courseware logo with the course.
- You will have access to a final report created by ProCert Labs.

If your course does not pass the initial review process:

- ProCert Labs will notify you and provide guidance to help you achieve 100% alignment.
- ProCert Labs will continue to work with you to get the course to a passing status.
