GoLive 9 offers new features to help make the web more accessible to designers who don't have a background in HTML or other web technologies. Use a visual CSS layout window to create standards-compliant code that renders faithfully on the latest browsers. Select, edit, and create objects using familiar tools and processes. And automatically create CSS-based text styles using character and style settings similar to those in InDesign.

### Work with other Adobe applications

GoLive 9 also offers close integration with other Adobe applications. Drag and drop content directly from InDesign, and GoLive automatically translates most existing character and paragraph styles into CSS. Maintain common color settings from other applications. You can even place native Adobe Photoshop®, Illustrator® and Adobe PDF files into GoLive as Smart Objects, which can be cropped and resized on-the-fly.

### Easily manage sites

With GoLive 9 software you can quickly bring your ideas to the web. Experience native performance on both Intel® and PowerPC® based Macs and on Microsoft® Windows Vista™ systems. Manage design assets with a Site Window that works much like Adobe Bridge, allowing you to visually track and maintain links and files. You can even make changes to multiple pages on a site offline and then synchronize them to your web server, uploading only the files that have been modified since the last update.

### Designer styles

Design with character and paragraph styles similar to those in InDesign but defined in CSS. Add new styles, edit existing ones, or delete old styles in the Control panel, or use the Style Options dialog box to define specific properties.

### Visual CSS layout

Use a visual CSS layout window to create or verify standards-compliant code that renders faithfully on the latest mobile devices and web browsers.

### Smart Objects

Save time by placing native Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, and PDF files into GoLive as Smart Objects, which re-render on-the-fly when you crop or resize them.

### Updated tools

Work with tools familiar to you from other Adobe applications to select, edit, and create objects on the page. Streamline the design process with new or revised versions of the Text, Container, and Deep Selection tools.

### Familiar site management tools

Manage your site from start to finish using a Site Window largely based on Adobe Bridge.

### Publish Server

Work on multiple pages on your site and then use the Publish Server to upload, download, and synchronize modified content.

### Adobe InDesign integration

Copy or drag specific content components between InDesign and GoLive. Preserve formatting or applied styles, and automatically translate them into CSS.

### Visual Collections interface

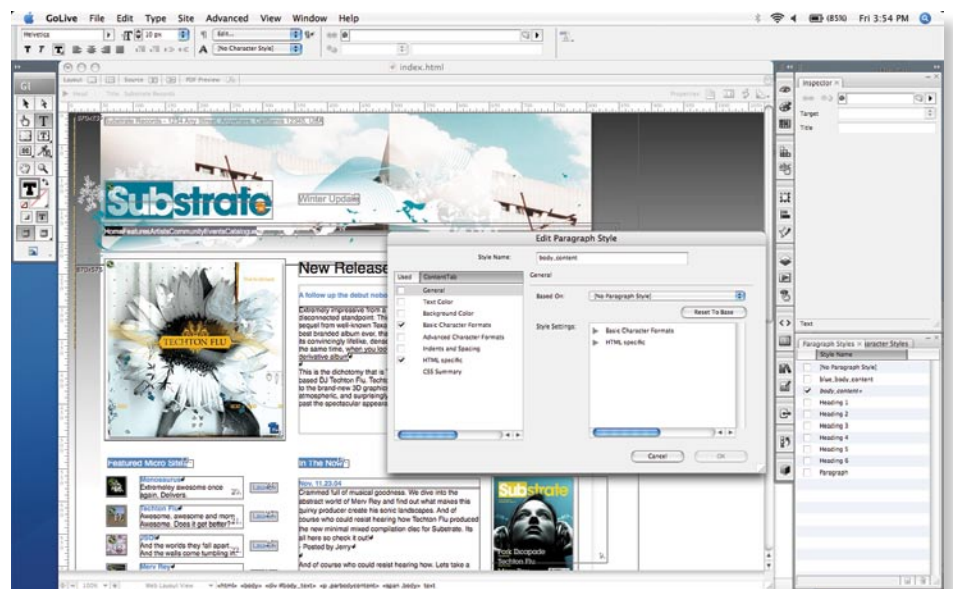
Manage your site assets at a granular level by easily filtering and publishing content directly from the Site Window.

### Place command

Conveniently place images and other content in pages using the File > Place command. If you place an image, the Save For Web feature automatically opens so you can optimize the image into the appropriate web format.

GoLive 9 is a universal binary application that runs natively on Intel based Macintosh computers. It has also been thoroughly tested on 32-bit versions of Windows Vista Home Premium, Business, Ultimate, and Enterprise editions.
